

## **HOMER AREA CHAMBER OF COMMERCE MEMBERSHIP STRUCTURE**

### **Honorary memberships**

Honorary memberships are defined as members of the community who hold an interest in the Chamber of Commerce. Honorary members do not have voting privileges, cannot hold an Office, and receive no promotional benefits.

### **Promotional memberships**

Promotional memberships are only available for those members who already have a membership under another business. This additional membership does not receive an extra voting right. Promotional memberships are for those who want to include their additional business(es) in any advertising we do as a Chamber. Each additional business added to an existing membership counts as an individual business and must be paid accordingly.

### **Retired memberships**

Retired memberships are available to those individuals who were Chamber members under a business membership and are retired from that business and wish to remain members. Retired members will not represent any business and will not receive any promotional benefits, but will retain the right to vote and the right to hold Office (can hold Office provided they have been a member in good standing for at least three years).

### **Non-profit memberships**

Non-profit memberships will hold full voting rights, and are eligible to hold an Officer position. The rate for non-profit members will be half of a full membership rate.

### **Business memberships**

Business memberships will receive all member benefits including the right to vote, hold Office, and participate in promotional advertising.

Note – all memberships are eligible to serve on Committees and hold Chairperson duties for said committee.

All Chamber memberships are eligible to receive promotional discounts where applicable.
